- Can be used in the rain and won't get heavier and more difficult to use due to water absorption.
- No more wood warp due to exposure to the elements. Less waste. Our forms are always straight.
- You can use them for a job, tear them down, clean them and put them away all in the same day.
- When it comes to leveling a job, it doesn't get any easier. All you have to do is unlock the clamp (CamLock) with one hand raise or lower it to any height you need and relock it. No more banging it with a hammer or pulling nails and re-hammering them in. It takes only seconds to adjust our forms. Set up and align our forms in seconds. And there's a bonus, NO SPLINTERS!
- Flexibility is a key advantage. No more trying to cut, soak or manipulate wood. Our forms are easy to bend and once used, they regain their original straight shape. They eliminate "bending boards".
- They can be used in all weather. From 4 degrees below zero to 40 degrees above zero.
- Slots along the back of the forms allows for placement of stakes or accessories anywhere along their length. No additional alterations necessary.
- Cutting them to different size doesn't hurt their usefulness. They can be cut to shape much more easily than wood, or metal, and can be easily cut and bent to almost any angle.
- Because they have a limited use (unlike wood or metal boards) theft is less of a problem.
- Our forms are specially treated to reduce clean up time. Concrete will not stick to our forms because they have smooth non-stick surface. They can be cleaned with a damp cloth to return them to a like new condition.
- Our forms are not affected by most cleaning chemicals and, if necessary, can be washed off with CTI Barracuda or hydrochloric acid to regain their new appearance.

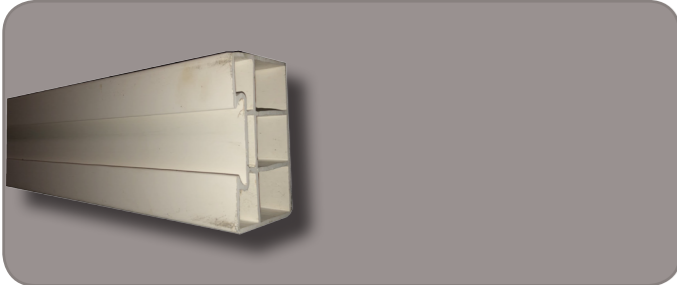

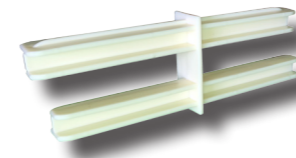


Camlocks (DCLLG)



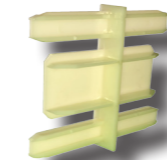
The adjustable Camlocks fit all sizes of plastic formwork and are used to quickly attached the boxing to the stakes.

90mm Long End Connector (DECL4)



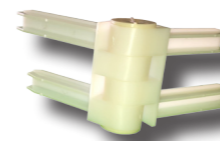
The straight connector is used to join two boards together when you don't need an angle. Can be used with Standard or Rigid Boards

90mm Straight Connector (DECL14)



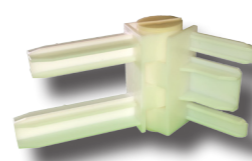
The straight connector is used to join two lengths of Super Flex board together.

90mm Hinged 35 x 35mm (DPF24-24)



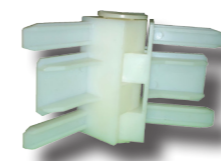
Hinged joiners join either rigid or standard board and can create internal or external corners at almost any angle you require.

90mm Hinged 35 x 19mm (DPF14-24)



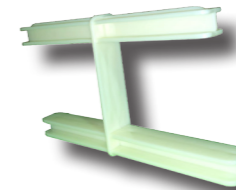
The 35 x 19mm Hinged connector joins Standard or rigid boards with Supa Flex boards to form corners of almost any angle.

90mm Hinged 19 x 19mm (DPF14-14)



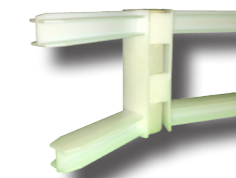
The 35 x 19mm Hinged connector joins Standard or rigid boards with Supa Flex boards to form corners of almost any angle.

150mm Long End Joiner (DECL6)



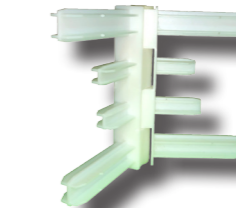
The straight connector is used to join two boards together when you don't need an angle. Can be used with Standard or Rigid 150mm Boards

150mm Hinged Connector (DPF26-26)



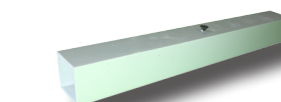
Hinged joiners join either rigid or standard 150mm board and can create internal or external corners at almost any angle you require.

203mm Hinged Connector (DPF28-28)



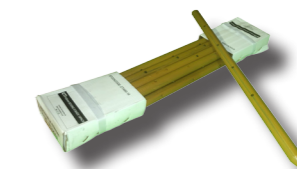
Hinged joiners join either rigid or standard 203mm boards and can create internal or external corners at almost any angle you require.

Square Connector (DSQCP1)



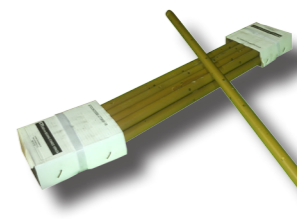
Square connectors are used to join 150mm or bigger boards together quickly
